



# CAMPING LA PEIRIERE

## Rules and regulations

### 1. - CAMPGROUND OPENING AND CLOSING DATES AND HOURS

The campground is completely closed from mid-November through the end of March. There are no exceptions to this rule, and no one is permitted to enter the premises.

Throughout the season: the automatic gate is open from 7:45 AM to 11:00 PM.  
An access badge will be provided to you upon arrival.

### 2. - RECEPTION DESK / INFORMATION DESK

Hours: 8:00 AM – 12:00 PM / 2:00 PM – 6:30 PM

At the reception desk, you can find all the information you need about the campground's services, local shopping options, sports facilities, nearby tourist attractions, and various useful addresses.

A campground staff member is available by phone every day during the season.

### 3. - ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

To be admitted to the campground and set up camp, you must have been authorized by the reception desk manager or the campground operator after completing the registration process. Minors must be accompanied by their parents or legal guardians. Staying on the campground premises implies acceptance of the provisions of these rules and a commitment to comply with them. Any violation may result in the offender's expulsion, with the assistance of law enforcement if necessary.

### 4. - POLICE REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

Any person planning to stay at least one night at the campground must first present their identification to the reception desk manager and complete the formalities required by the police. (Pursuant to the provisions of Decree No. 75-410 of May 20, 1975, only foreign campers are now subject to these police formalities.)

### 5. - SETUP

Tents, trailers, bungalows, or any other equipment must be set up on the site designated by the operator. Guests must respect the overall appearance of the campground; specifically, the site must not be cluttered with any other structures or personal belongings other than the trailer or bungalow being used, in accordance with regulations governing outdoor lodging facilities.

### 7. - NOISE AND QUIET

Campground guests are strongly urged to avoid any noise or loud conversations that might disturb their neighbors. Audio devices must be kept at a reasonable volume. Car doors and trunks should be closed as quietly as possible.

Complete silence is required between 11:00 PM and 7:00 AM.

### 8. - VISITORS

Visitors may be admitted to the campground under the responsibility of the campers hosting them, who must report the number of visitors and their identities to the front desk. Access to the swimming pool is not permitted.

## **9. - VEHICLE TRAFFIC AND PARKING**

Within the campground, vehicles must not exceed a speed limit of 10 km/h and must obey all on-site traffic signs. Traffic is prohibited between 11:00 PM and 7:00 AM. Only one vehicle is permitted per campsite unless otherwise authorized by management and upon payment of an additional fee.

Parking in the outdoor lot: guests are advised to take the usual precautions to safeguard their vehicles and belongings; the campground accepts no liability for damage, breakage, or theft.

Only vehicles belonging to campers staying at the campground are permitted to drive within the campground. Parking must not obstruct traffic or prevent new arrivals from setting up. During peak season, vehicles must be parked on their owners' sites or in the parking lot located at the entrance.

Visitors must park their vehicles outside the campground and report their arrival at the reception desk.

## **10. - RENTAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

All guests are required to refrain from any action that could compromise the cleanliness, hygiene, or appearance of the campground. Children must always be under the supervision of their parents. It is prohibited to pour wastewater onto the ground or into the gutters. Campers must empty their wastewater into the facilities provided for this purpose.

Household trash, waste of any kind, and paper must be placed in the communal trash bins at the campground entrance. It is prohibited to wash cars inside the campground. It is prohibited to draw water from fire hydrants and fire hoses, as these are reserved exclusively for that purpose and for no other use.

Washing laundry is strictly prohibited outside the designated laundry sinks, and laundry must never be hung on trees. Plants and floral decorations must be respected. Campers are prohibited from driving nails into trees, cutting branches, or planting anything. All construction and improvements are prohibited unless expressly authorized by the operator.

It is also prohibited to mark the boundaries of a campsite using personal materials or to dig in the ground. Any damage caused to vegetation, fences, the ground, or campground facilities will be the responsibility of the person who caused it. Campers are strictly prohibited from connecting directly to the water pumps. Any occupant wishing to connect to the running water supply must be equipped with a shut-off valve. Electrical power supplied: 10 amps. The restrooms may be closed during the off-season and shoulder seasons, and for as long as adverse weather conditions persist.

## **11. - SAFETY**

### **A - Fire**

Open fires, including barbecues (wood, charcoal, etc.), are strictly prohibited outside the designated area. Camping stoves must be kept in good working order.

The campground's gas installations must comply with current regulations.

Regarding gas cylinders, to prevent any risk of explosion, the following maximum number may be installed:

- In tents: 2 gas cylinders weighing up to 3 kg each;
- In caravans, mobile homes, and light recreational dwellings: 2 gas cylinders weighing up to 13 kg each."

Fire extinguishers are available to everyone; in the event of a fire, notify management immediately. Three sirens on the campground are used to alert guests within the campground grounds. A first-aid kit is located at the front desk, along with emergency contact numbers for various services.

In the event of an evacuation of the campground, please follow the evacuation arrows and gather at the assembly point located in the parking lot.

#### B - Cigarettes

Smokers are asked to exercise extreme caution when smoking outside their accommodations. It is strictly prohibited to drop cigarette butts on the ground; the use of an ashtray is mandatory.

#### C - Theft

Immediately report any suspicious individuals on the campground to the manager. Guests are asked to take the usual precautions to safeguard their belongings stored on the campground. Management is not responsible for the safekeeping of personal items or equipment.

### **12. - GAMES**

No violent or disruptive games may be played near the facilities. Playgrounds are available for children under the sole responsibility of their parents. It is mandatory to adhere to the age restrictions for each game. Access to the various communal facilities, playgrounds, swimming pool, etc., is at the users' own risk. Unaccompanied visitors and unaccompanied minors are not permitted on the premises.

### **13. - OUR FURRY FRIENDS**

Dogs and other animals must not be allowed to roam freely or even be left locked up on the campground while their owners—who are legally responsible for them—are absent. Their behavior must not disturb the peace, safety, or cleanliness of the campground. Their waste must be picked up by their owners. Animals are not allowed in the showers. They are not permitted for visitors.

The customer must then provide proof of insurance and vaccination for the animal in accordance with the house rules and memos. Dogs classified as Category 1 “attack dogs” (pit bulls, etc.) and Category 2 “guard and defense dogs” (Rottweilers and similar breeds) are prohibited. For all animals, a surcharge will apply for both open campsites and rental accommodations (current rates apply).

### **14. - SWIMMING POOL**

A - Access - Access to the swimming pool is free and strictly reserved for campground guests, who must comply with health and safety rules and the pool regulations posted at the entrance to the footbath. Minors must be accompanied by their parents, who are solely responsible for supervising them. The swimming pool is open from late May to early September every day from 9:30 AM to 7:00 PM.

B - Rules - Pets are strictly prohibited within the swimming pool area.

The management and its staff accept no liability for accidents occurring within the swimming pool area. It is prohibited to eat, drink, or smoke, or to enter the pool area with shoes on.

Showering is mandatory. It is imperative to respect the premises, other swimmers, and the pool's rules and regulations.

C - Liability - Compliance with the pool's rules and regulations is mandatory and applies to all guests upon entry. The pool is unsupervised, and use is at the swimmers' own risk. At certain times, a management representative may be assigned to ensure compliance with the pool's rules and regulations. In the event of non-compliance, and depending on the severity of the violation, management may decide to temporarily or permanently exclude the offender.

### **15. - STORAGE AREA**

Unattended equipment may only be left on the premises with the Management's prior approval and only in the designated area. A fee, the amount of which will be posted at the office, will be charged for the “storage area.”

## **16. - CAMPGROUND MANAGER**

The manager is responsible for maintaining order and ensuring the proper upkeep of the campground. The manager is authorized to impose penalties for serious violations of the rules and, if necessary, to expel those responsible. Disrespectful or aggressive behavior toward the manager or other guests will result in immediate expulsion without notice.

## **17. - SANITARY FACILITIES – SEWAGE SYSTEM**

The campground is equipped with an independent sanitation system featuring a septic tank. For this reason, and also for environmental reasons, we ask all our guests to use organic, bleach-free cleaning products. These areas must be left clean. In the event of failure to maintain cleanliness, and after several warnings, the guest may be expelled without further notice.

## **18. - POSTING**

These rules and regulations, as well as the evacuation instructions, are posted at the entrance to the campground and in the restroom facilities on the signs provided for that purpose. They are provided to guests upon request and are available online. They may be modified at any time without notice.

## **19. - VIOLATION OF THE RULES AND REGULATIONS**

In the event that a resident disrupts the stay of other users or fails to comply with the provisions of these rules and regulations, the manager or their representative may, verbally or in writing if deemed necessary, issue a formal notice to the resident to cease the disturbance.

In the event of a serious or repeated violation of the house rules and after the manager has issued a formal notice to comply, the manager may terminate the contract. In the event of a criminal offense, the manager may call upon law enforcement.

## **20. - DAMAGE**

Any damage will result in a repair bill, which will be the customer's responsibility, whether or not covered by insurance. It is expressly noted that children are the responsibility of their parents.

## **21. - LAKE AND MINI FARM**

Animals must not be fed, and under no circumstances may guests be violent toward our animals. Access to the lake and the mini farm is closed from 8:00 PM until 8:00 AM.

In the event of an accident, the campground assumes no liability. For obvious safety reasons, minors must not under any circumstances be left alone on the campground grounds or in the rental units.

**WARNING:** We remind parents that it is strictly forbidden for their minor children, or those under their supervision, to play alone near the lake. Children must be under constant supervision at all times and must not play or walk alone around this body of water.

## **22. - RESTAURANT**

Our restaurant is open daily for lunch and dinner (except for lunch on Mondays in April, May, and June) from 12:00 PM to 2:00 PM and from 7:00 PM to 10:00 PM. We offer homemade dishes, grill specials, meat and fish, salads, and traditional burgers and pizzas.

We also have a takeout menu for lunch and dinner (pizzas, burgers, salads, tapas, desserts, etc.). You can reserve a table by visiting the bar, calling 0468454650, or booking independently via the Zenchef link available on our social media and under the "Restaurant" tab on our website.

## **23. - THE HEART OF THE CAMPGROUND**

The heart of the campground is the bar and reception area. You're welcome to come here to relax, have a drink, meet people, and ask for information about the campground and the region. We're here to help with any questions you may have.

**24. - WIFI**

Free Wi-Fi is available on the terrace at the bar; the password is posted at the bar and available upon request.

**25. - TRASH CANS**

Trash cans for household waste and glass are available at the entrance to the parking lot. Please dispose of your trash properly and be eco-friendly. The trash cans are reserved for campers only.

**26. - VIDEO SURVEILLANCE**

The campground's common areas and the parking lot are under video surveillance.

**27. - IN CASE OF EMERGENCY**

Please notify management in case of an emergency.
